I am writing on behalf of Portmore Park and District Residents Association to express our objections to the planning application number 2006/1813 for the development of land to rear of 20 & 20A Church Street, Weybridge.

Yesterday, at a meeting of our association committee, when we saw what is proposed for this site we concluded that we must strongly oppose the application.

- It proposes over-dense piecemeal development of a prominent and highly visible town centre site.
- It would have an inevitable negative impact on parking for legitimate users of the adjacent hospital car park.
- The nature of site access is highly questionable.

These are matters for serious concern, and we hope you will give them due weight. We find this a very strange planning application. It must surely be refused consent.
